Our 2025/2026 school year will begin on Thursday, August 14, 2025. This letter contains basic information which will help in planning for the new school year.

Arrival & Dismissal

Breakfast will be served from 7:15 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. Classroom instruction begins promptly at 7:45 a.m. If you would like for your student(s) to receive breakfast, we encourage you to have your student(s) to school no later than 7:30 am to ensure that they have ample time to eat and report to class for instruction. The school day will end at 3:15 p.m. with a staggered dismissal time for the first few months. Traffic flow for arrival and dismissal are within this welcome packet.

School Meals Program

Free breakfast and lunch will be provided to all scholars. Menus are sent home monthly.

Dress Code

The welcome packet contains our dress code guidelines. Please review them carefully with your child(ren).

School Closing Announcements

There are often situations in which it is necessary to close the school. Sheffield Academy airs school closings on local news channels and SchoolStatus. We typically close for inclement weather along with the local school districts; however, occasionally we find the weather conditions too harsh for our children during times when the Public Schools remain open. Depend on the news and your best discretion during poor weather conditions.

Contact Information

Please make sure we have any updated contact information for you and your student's emergency contacts. We need to be prepared and able to respond efficiently should an emergency of any kind arise. You can change your information by stopping into the office or a form can be sent home upon request.

School Correspondence

Please check your scholar's backpacks and/or folders daily for notices and announcements from the school. We often send reminders and flyers regarding upcoming events to keep our family members aware of school activities. Classroom teachers also send important information regarding classroom activities and academics home on a regular basis. The teachers and school will be using a platform called SchoolStatus to keep you updated on upcoming events and day-to-day happenings with your student and the school. You should receive a text message from SchoolStatus prior to school starting. If you have not received one before the end of July, please contact our front office.
