Progress towards Goals

The percent proficient in ELA on the state assessment remained almost the same at 45% in SY2024 to 44.3% in SY2025.

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment increased from 32.5% in SY2024 to 47.5% in SY2025.

Sheffield Academy has added over 120 students since we opened in 2022.

Our Academic Goals

#1 By FY2028, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state tests in English Language Arts and Mathematics will increase by 30%.

#2 By June 2028, the performance of students will improve by decreasing the discipline occurrences by 15%.

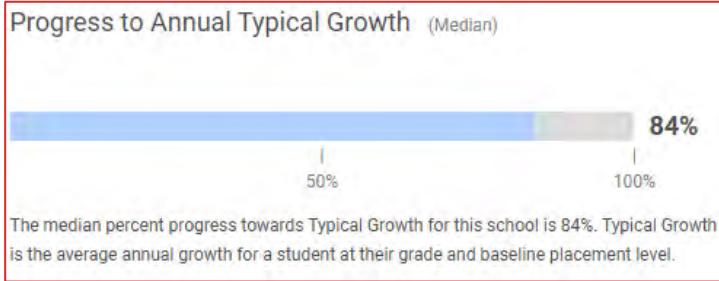

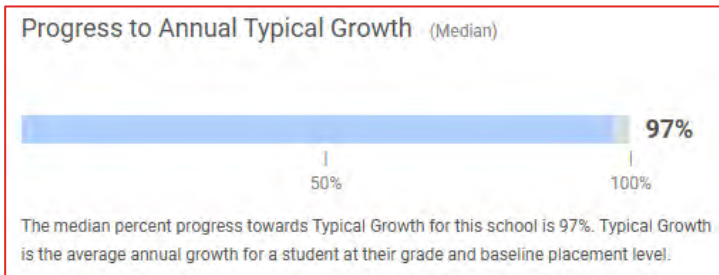

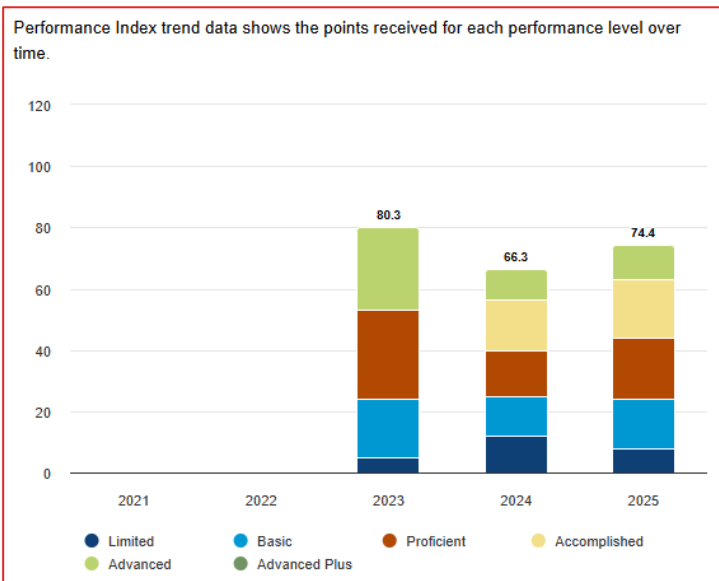
iReady Data Reading

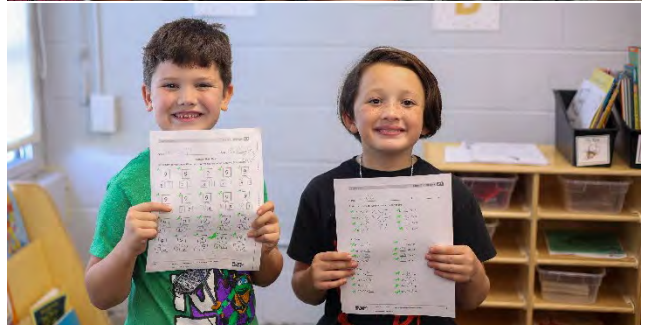
